

Graphics Commander

User Manual

This tool was originally developed for Facebook, and you will be able to create fanpage covers, coupons, memes, fangates, ads, tabs, and other kind of marketing graphics, including custom sizes up to 2000px wide.

I like to start by selecting my template size first, and then browsing through the templates on the bottom left. Sometimes I start with a cover template, then change the size to “custom”, easily turning that into a website header. It’s easy!

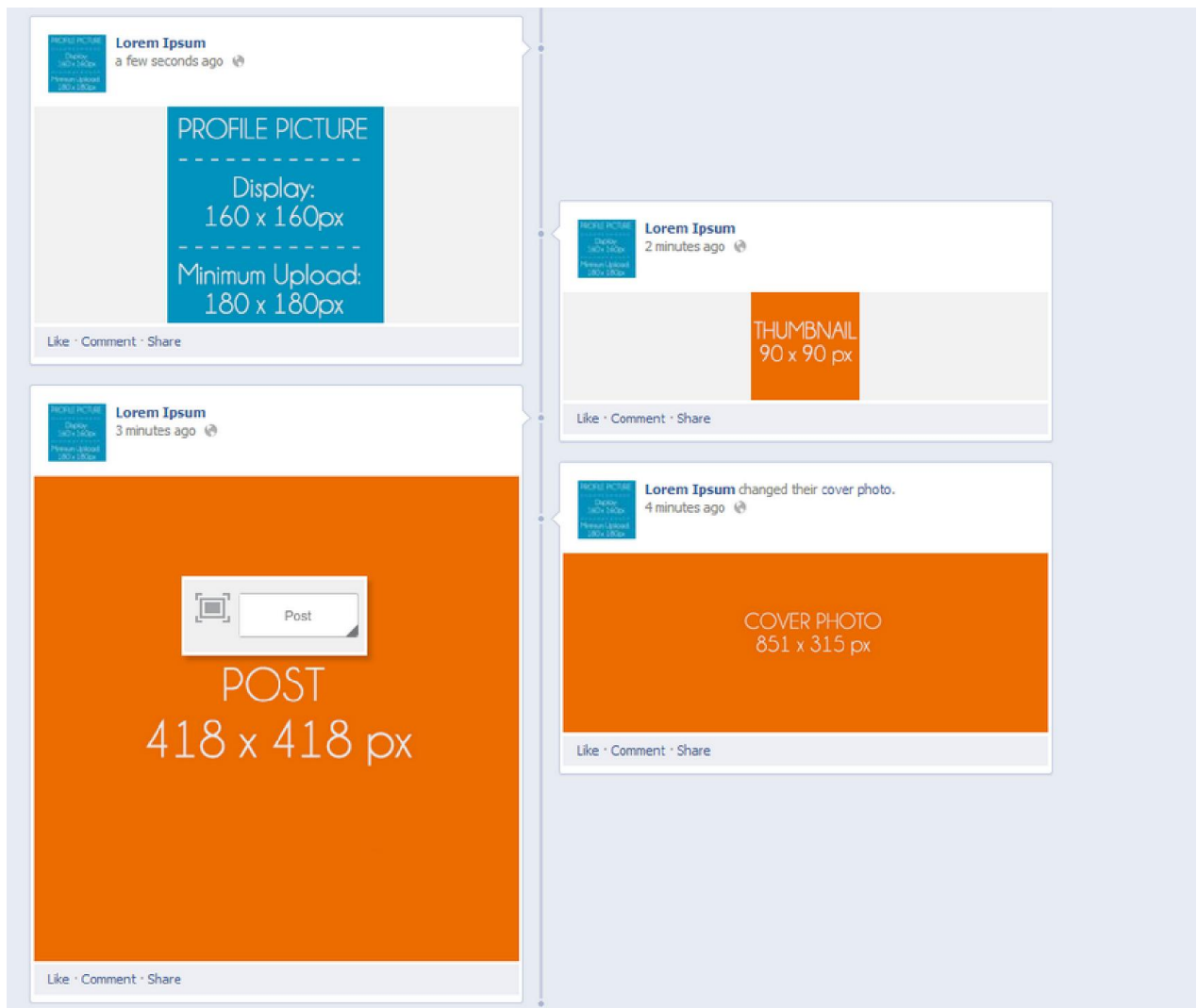
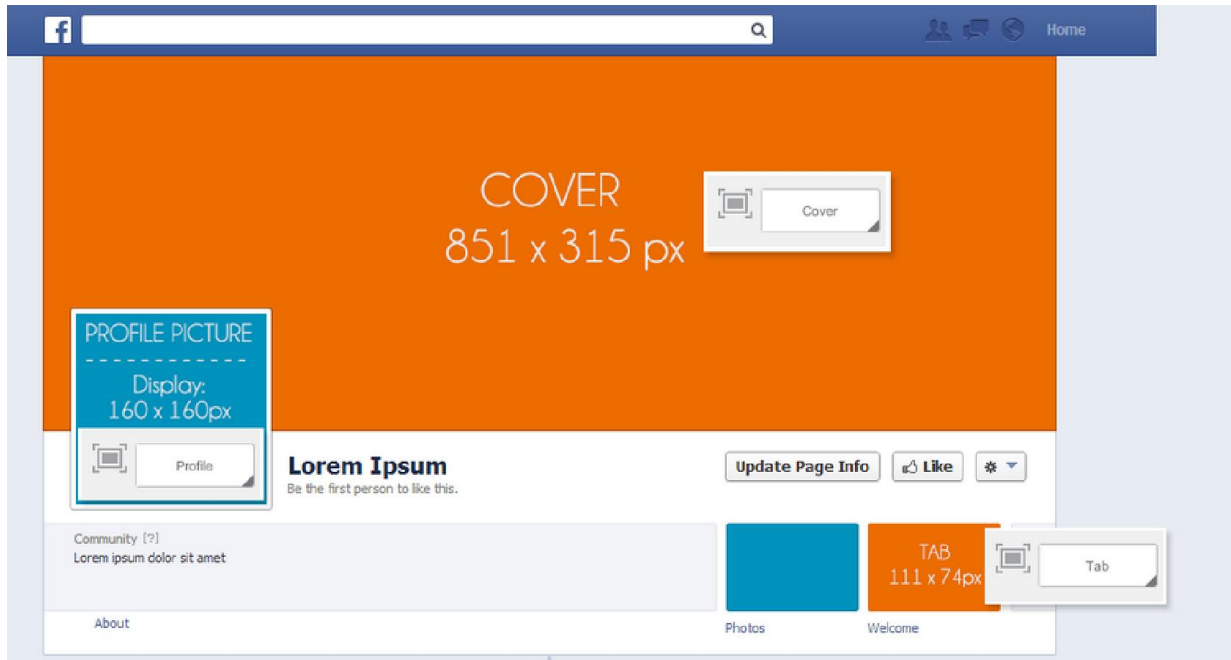
How to use

Start Here

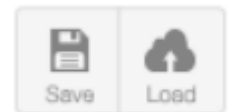
Download your final art:



Once you are done designing your graphic, simply click on the blue Download button to download the design to your desktop. The file will always be called facebook.png

If you rename the file, you **MUST** include the .png in the name or the file cannot be opened.

How to save your designs:



To save your design layouts, and come back to edit it at any point in the future follow these steps.

1. Click on the Save button. This will save your design as an XML file.
2. Rename it appropriately, example "fanpagecover.xml" and save

To Open an existing design, click on the Load button and upload your XML file., returning your designs and our graphics to the canvas. Note that this will ***not*** include custom art you have uploaded.
